## **Assertions**

- 1) Per 720.30851, The Meadows South Association, Inc. will issue an Estoppel Certificate within 10 business days after receiving a written or electronic request for an estoppel certificate from a parcel owner, the parcel owner's designee, a parcel mortgagee, or the parcel mortgagee's designee.
- 2) If additional information or a mistake related to the estoppel certificate becomes known to the Association within the effective period, an amended estoppel certificate may be delivered and becomes effective if a sale or refinancing of the parcel has not been completed during the effective period. No fee will be charged for an amended estoppel certificate and a new 30 or 35-day effective period begins on the date of issuance of the amended estoppel certificate.
- 3) The Association waives the right to collect any monies owed in excess of the amounts specified in the estoppel certificate from any person who in good faith relies upon the estoppel certificate and from the person's successors and assigns.
- 4) If an association receives a request for an estoppel certificate from a duly authorized person as stated above and fails to deliver the estoppel certificate within ten (10) business days, a fee may not be charged for the preparation and delivery of the estoppel certificate.
- 5) The maximum 10-day preparation fee for an estoppel certificate is \$250. The maximum, 3-day, expedited preparation fee for an estoppel certificate is \$350. If the parcel owner is delinquent in dues & assessments at the time of the estoppel certificate request, the maximum statutory charge is limited to \$150.
- 6) The Meadows South Association estoppel certificate preparation and delivery policy is published on its website: <a href="www.msahoa.com">www.msahoa.com</a>. The policy was adopted by the Association's Board of Directors on February 15, 2025 at a duly noticed Board meeting.
- 7) If the certificate is requested in conjunction with the sale or mortgage of a parcel, but the closing does not occur for which the certificate was sought, the Association shall refund the estoppel fee provided the requestor notifies the Association, in writing, within 30 days of the scheduled closing and provides reasonable documentation that the sale did not occur from a payor. Any such estoppel fees will be refunded within 30 days of the request.
- 8) The refund is the obligation of the parcel owner. The Association may collect it from that owner in the same manner as an assessment as provided in Florida statute. The right to reimbursement may not be waived or modified by any contract or agreement. The prevailing party in any action brought to enforce a right of reimbursement shall be awarded damages and all applicable attorney fees and costs.
